\*Archivist's Note: The order of battle for W Force does not refer to a 2/2<sup>nd</sup> Army Field Workshop *per se*. The nearest we get is:

2/2<sup>nd</sup> Field Regiment, Royal Australian Artillery and  
2/2<sup>nd</sup> Field Company, Royal Australian Engineers.

Buckley only refers to:

2/2<sup>nd</sup> Australian Field Regiment (Artillery).

This latter title is corroborated in a Wikipedia site describing the 6<sup>th</sup> Division. Thus, for the purpose of current research it will be accepted as correct, although some future clarification is obviously required.
